

**DIRECTIONS MADE AT THE PRELIMINARY INQUIRY HEARING ON 22 NOVEMBER
2019**

At the preliminary hearing held at Manchester Town Hall on 22 November 2019 the Chairman to the Inquiry, Sir John Saunders, gave the following directions:

1. The qualified lawyers listed in the annex to this order are each designated as the recognised legal representative for the Core Participant ('CP') they are instructed to represent in the Inquiry, pursuant to Rule 6 of the Inquiry Rules 2006.

GMP Statements

2. The outstanding Command and Control statements from Greater Manchester Police ('GMP'), including their corporate statement on matters relevant to the Inquiry, are to be served on the Chairman in draft form by no later than **4pm on 6 December 2019**.

Disclosure

3. Any submissions from Counsel to the Inquiry ('CTI') and on behalf of any other CP in response to the request for further information about the materials withheld from disclosure as a result of the 13 September 2019 ruling on public interest immunity in the Inquests to be served on the Chairman by **4pm on 6 December 2019**.

Position Statements

4. Any further written submissions by those CPs represented by BJC and Hudgells in relation to the issue of position statements to be served on the Chairman by **4pm on 13 December 2019**.
5. Written submissions made on behalf of any other CP on the issue of position statements to be served on the Chairman by **4pm on 10 January 2020**.
6. Written submissions made by CTI on the issue of position statements to be served on the Chairman by **4pm on 27 January 2020**.

GMP Radio Audio

7. GMP to provide the Chairman with an update on the searches for and copies of any further GMP audio of radio transmissions from 22 / 23 May 2017 by no later than **4pm on 2 December 2019**.

8. The results of the further assurance process carried out for any outstanding GMP radio audio by the systems provider which manages the GMP server to be given to the Chairman by no later than **4pm on 31 December 2019**.

9. A further preliminary hearing to take place at the Manchester Town Hall on **28 January 2020**.
