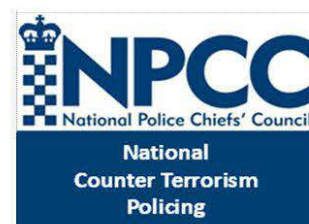

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SECTION 1 – INTRODUCTION

Project ARGUS – Stadia is a facilitation awareness programme directed to CEOs, senior managers, safety and security managers and specialists for Stadia, Arena and Event holders. Its aim is to identify the measures that can assist in preventing, responding, managing and recovering from a terrorist attack at a venue or event. (Including targeting by organised crime groups)

It is therefore necessary to review our current procedures, highlight the importance of being prepared and having the necessary plans and processes in place to safeguard people and assets.

SECTION 2 – AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Aims:

Project Argus is designed to:

- **Identify the measures that can assist in preventing, handling and recovering from a terrorist attack**
- **Increase preparedness and consolidate resilience in relation to a potential terrorist attack that could pose a risk to core functions of the organisation**
- **To highlight the importance of being prepared and having the necessary plans in place to help safeguard staff, visitors and assets**

Project ARGUS specifically looks to raise awareness of the potential negative impact on core business and key infrastructure from a terrorist attack.

Objectives:

Candidates will be able to:

- **Identify risk and threat types impacting on the ability to conduct business as usual, which trigger business continuity and consequence management plans**
- **Explain the necessity for implementation of appropriate threat mitigation strategies within their own working environment**
- **Apply appropriate strategies to mitigate identified risks and threats from a terrorist attack**
- **Identify sources of protective security guidance material**
- **Identify appropriate recording and reporting protocols in relation to identified risks and threats from such an incident**
- **Suggest ways to improve effectiveness and efficiency in identifying, managing, and resolving threat or risk related activities**

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
