We are planning to hold an Argus event in Manchester City Centre (venue to be confirmed) in conjunction with Manchester Business Continuity Forum (MBCF). Many of the larger organisations and businesses within Manchester have participated in such events specifically for their sites and found them very useful.

Project Argus is a workshop-based exercise designed to inform and advise delegates on good practice for preparing a response to a serious emergency such as a terrorist attack.

Both the NWCTU CTSA's and the MBCF have identified a gap in this area for SMEs (small and medium sized enterprises) and therefore this event is being held in order to enable smaller companies and organisations to send representatives from their sites without the worry of excessive abstractions and covering of shifts etc. that would be needed for an event of this nature to be delivered in-house.
