#### Argus Stadia

The Project ARGUS Stadia product has been reviewed and five dates and venues have been identified for the delivery of Project ARGUS Stadia 'plus', around the UK.

An invitation to key partners will be sent out the week commencing Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2016 by [Irrelevant & Sensitive] NCTPHQ. CTSA/CTAA will be invited to attend and observe in order that a consistent product can be cascaded nationally.
