Stakeholder Update

News and information from the Manchester Arena Inquiry for the week ahead

The Inquiry will sit two days this week - Monday 29th to Tuesday 30th March with hearings commencing at 10.00am. This week we will continue to hear evidence related to Chapter 10 - the emergency service response to the attack on 22nd May 2017. This week we will revert to hearing background evidence related to policy, joint working and training.

On Monday we begin with Roy Wilsher, Chair of the National Fire Chiefs Council, which provides advice to governments and represents the wider sector on matters such as professional standards, operational guidance, research and sharing best practice. Mr Wilshire will give evidence related to the NFCC guidance on MTFA incidents.

We will then hear evidence from Greater Manchester Police Chief Inspector Mike Booth. As Chief Inspector in the Operational Communications Branch, CI Booth held oversight of the Force Duty Officer role and developed the MTFA Action Cards for GMP. He may go part-heard over night.

On Tuesday we will hear from retired Greater Manchester Police Superintendent Leor Giladi who will give evidence about GMP attendance at Greater Manchester Resilience Forum meetings, his role in planning the JOPs Commander training that took place in early 2017 and GMP Plato policies. Mr Giladi is former chair of the JESIP User Group.

The Inquiry will not sit the week of the 5th April - hearings will resume on 12th April.
