

Stakeholder Update

News and information from the Manchester Arena Inquiry for the week ahead

This week, the Manchester Arena Inquiry plans to sit on Monday 13th, Wednesday 15th, Thursday 16th and Friday 17th September with hearings commencing at 9.30am. There will be no hearing on Tuesday 14th September.

On Monday we will continue to hear evidence from the Inquiry's independent ambulance experts Michael Herriot and Christian Cooper. On Wednesday, Thursday and Friday we will hear evidence from the independent policing experts Ian Dickinson, Iain Sirrell and Scott Wilson. This will conclude the oral evidence on Chapter 10 which covers the emergency response to the attack.
