

Stakeholder Update

News and information from the Manchester Arena Inquiry for the week ahead

This week the Manchester Arena Inquiry plans to sit from Monday 27th to Friday 1st October with hearings commencing at 9.30am.

From Monday to Thursday, the Inquiry will continue to hear Chapter 12 evidence concerning the experience of each of the 22 who died in the attack. On Monday, the Inquiry will hear the evidence in respect of Megan Hurley, Eilidh MacLeod and Sorrell Leczkowski. A number of witnesses will be giving evidence about their interaction with Megan Hurley. Pursuant to a Restriction Order made by the Chairman on 24 September 2021, there will be a short restricted hearing during Monday's evidence. On Tuesday, the Inquiry will hear the evidence in respect of Kelly Brewster, and Liam Curry and Chloe Rutherford. Witnesses will be called to provide evidence about their interaction with Kelly Brewster. On Wednesday, we will hear the evidence in respect of Georgina Callander and will also hear from a number of individuals involved in treating her that night. On Thursday we will hear the evidence, and from witnesses, in respect of both Martyn Hett and Elaine McIver.

On Friday there will be a preliminary hearing to consider restriction order applications for Chapter 14.
